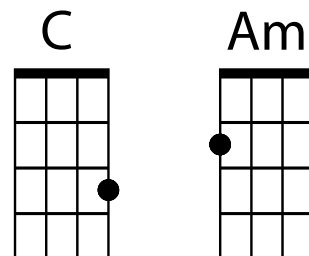

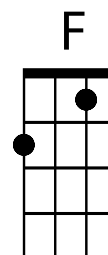
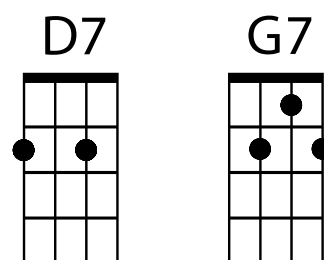
Verse 1
